By order of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, ALL undergraduate students must prove to be ineligible for the Federal Pell Grant and/or Federal SEOG in order to qualify for assistance under the Hazlewood Act. This may be done by completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available in the UTPA Financial Aid Office, SSB 186.

Students who do not officially withdraw through the Office of Admissions and Records will be responsible for tuition, fees, and any circumstances arising from failure to withdraw.
